Industry Visited: Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Private Limited (HCCBPL)

A batch of B.com (Banking & Insurance) 9 students and Assistant Professor Mr. Jidnesh D.Vetal visited the **Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Private Limited (HCCBPL)** at Ameenpur, Miyapur, Hyderabad. This unit is mainly focusing on the preparation of all Beverages that comes under COCACOLA Brand.

The session was begin with Audio-Visual explanation of Plant and their working. Student got the fresh batch samples of Thumps-up to Drink.



Mr.V.Surya Narayan Raju, Executive at Hindustan Coca-Cola Beverages Private Limited (HCCBPL) addressed the students and introduced about the company. He explained about the functioning of this Unit. Later he explained the different steps employed for the safety of the unit. Most of the raw materials

used in the preparation of beverage are highly inflammable. He also warned the students how to reach a safe assembly point if any accident happens in the unit during visit.

Later Mr.V.Surya Narayan Raju explained the agenda of the day. The agenda was observation on:

1. Basic Bottle purification.
2. Contents use in Beverages.
3. Systematic filling of Beverage.
4. Tapping of Bottles.
5. Arrangements of Crates.
6. Automated packing of Bottle in Crates.

During this session, students interacted with the Executive very effectively. Particularly about the Machine working behind the Beverage and their identification, isolation and storage. Then Mr.V.Surya Narayan Raju, Executive explained the chemistry of the solution compounds. He mainly focused on the storage of the raw materials after procuring. He explained how to store the liquids in cold storage plant and air sensitive compounds under sensitive atmosphere.





During the trip students gained practical knowledge about the handling of the raw materials having different characteristics and properties. Many of the points explained theoretically in the first session were explained again practically. In Quality control unit, students were explained how 90% of all the work at plant is operated by machines which was imported from Japan.

After this session all the students expressed their thanks to the officials for the opportunity given. This trip was highly useful for the students in terms of practical knowledge about the beverage compounds. This trip will also be helpful for them to find placement opportunities in such industries.
