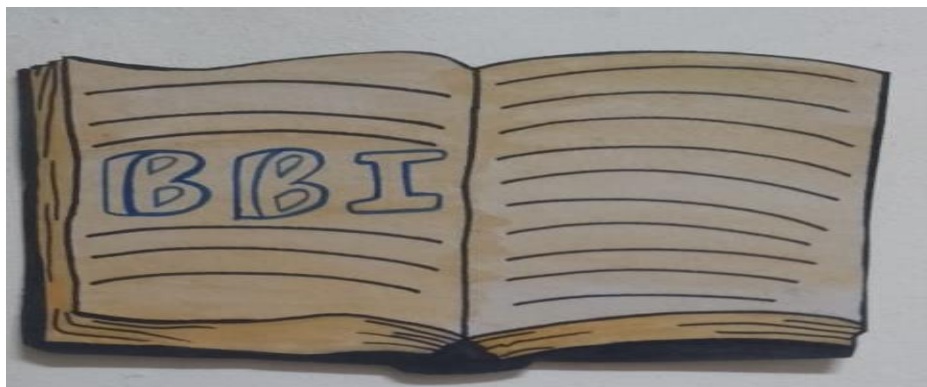


This is an event where students take a brief time off their busy schedule and strive hard to acclaim proficiency in the field of games.

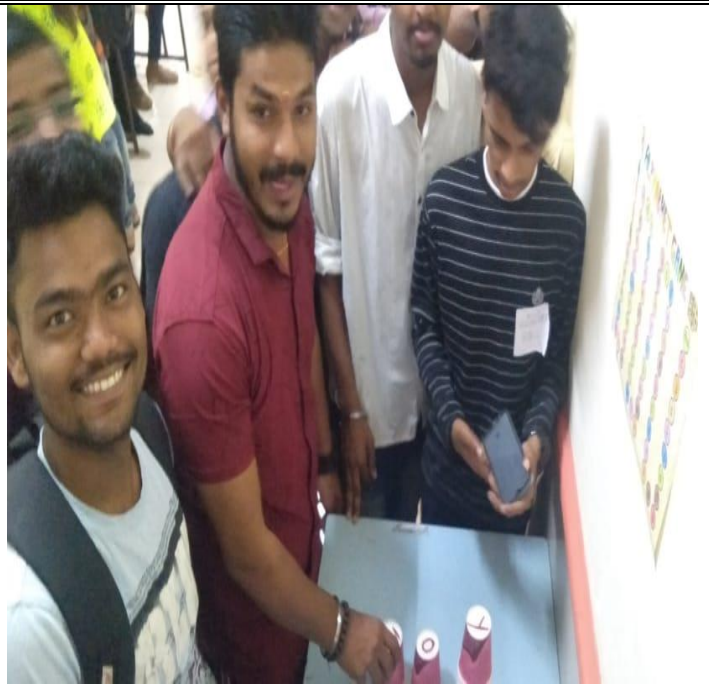

Report On Industrial Visit

CHANDIGARH- 22ND January 2020 - 30TH January 2020

Industry Visited:

1)INTERSOLAR

A batch of B.com (Banking & Insurance) of G.E.S.'s, B.V.College of Arts, Science &Commerce Borivali, 15 students and Assistant Professor Mr. Jidnesh D.Vetal visited the **INTERSOLAR (Solar Heater & Solar Panel)** at Plot NO.901-A, Industrial Area Phase-III, Chandigarh - 160002. This unit is mainly focusing on the preparation of Solar Heater & Solar Panel.

The session was begin with Verbal explanation of Plant and their working. Student got to see the actual manufacturing process of Solar Panels which was on-going at plant.



An Executive at INTERSOLAR addressed the students and introduced about the company. He explained about the functioning of this Unit. Later he explained the different steps employed for the safety of the unit. Most of the raw materials used in the preparation of Solar Panels are highly prone to damage. He also warned the students how to reach a safe assembly point if any accident happens in the unit during visit.

Later executives explained the agenda of the day. The agenda was observation on:

1. EL Tester.
2. Layup.
3. Bussing.
4. Doping.
5. Stringing.
6. Lamination Framing etc.

During this session, students interacted with the Executive very effectively. Particularly about the Machine working behind each steps and manual work needed for it.. Then the Executive explained the how the manual

work is done and safety procedures which has to be followed by every employee working in premises. He explained how to each solar panel is tested by the similar effects drawn by a machine which imitates exactly the rays of sun for split seconds.



During the trip students gained practical knowledge about the handling of the raw materials having different characteristics and properties. Many of the points explained theoretically. In Quality control unit, students were explained how 50% of all the work at plant is operated by machines.



After this session all the students expressed their thanks to the officials for the opportunity given. This trip was highly useful for the students in terms of practical knowledge of making of solar panels. This trip will also be helpful for them to find placement opportunities in such industries.

2)Industry Visited: AMARTEX Industries Pvt.Ltd.

This unit manufactures different types of garments. It is founded by Grover

Family in 1988. Amartex has 24 retail outlets selling ready-made garments under the brand name Groviano Italy.



The session was begin with Verbal explanation of weaving factor at the location. Student got to see the actual weaving process of Men's suiting and shirting.

Executive at AMARTEX addressed the students and introduced about the company. He explained steps employed for the safety of manufacturing plant and their employees. Students got to see how a batch of thread is working in a weaving machine, making fine garment under supervision.
