



In the session the guest explained the causes of social exclusivity, its consequences in the daily life and also talked about different kinds of stereotypes that people face and emphasised on the importance of breaking these stereotypes.

Department of Political Science and Department of Sociology jointly organised One Day Seminar for students on **'Socio- Political Barriers in the upliftment of Women and Queer'** on 6th February 2023 and distinguished speakers for the same was Dr. Amruta Deshmukh, HOD, Department of Political Science, Chetana College, Borivali- (W) and Ms. Apurva Paithane, COO, The QKnit Foundation, Thane.
